Students in years 5-8 are offered the Great Kiwi Canterbury exams which are completed digitally. These are offered in English, Mathematics and Science. Students in years 3-8 are offered ICAS exams which are the Cambridge exam system. These are a pencil and paper exam. These are offered in Digital Technologies, Science, Spelling, Writing, English and Mathematics. All students have brought a notice home about these exams.
